



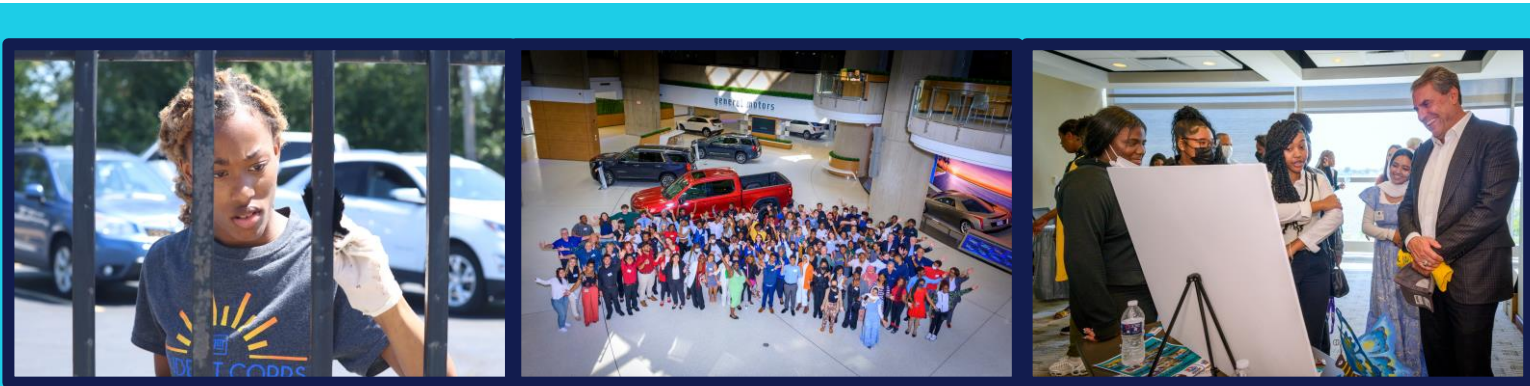
## GENERAL MOTORS STUDENT CORPS

### Program Description

GM Student Corps is a comprehensive, paid summer internship program for high school students in metro-Detroit, Flint and Pontiac that encompasses community service, life skills training, team building and mentoring. The program is centered around professional development to prepare students to tackle today's challenges and become tomorrow's leaders.

Each participating school team consists of 8 high school interns, 2 GM retirees and 1 college intern. Teams work together to develop their own community service projects in their school or neighborhood. Examples include painting in their school, renovating athletic facilities or community parks and implementing a neighborhood recycling program.

In addition to service projects, the program exposes high school interns to career and educational opportunities and weekly life skills lessons to cover important topics such as money management, professional development and business etiquette. At the end of the program, high school interns present their achievements to General Motors senior executive staff.



### 2023 Program Details

GM Student Corps 2023 is a 8-week program running from June 20<sup>th</sup> to August 10<sup>th</sup>. Student interns work three days per week, Tuesday through Thursday, with their team. Attendance is vital to individual and team success.

### High School Intern Compensation

Students are paid as salaried General Motors employees at a rate of \$15.00 per hour.

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
